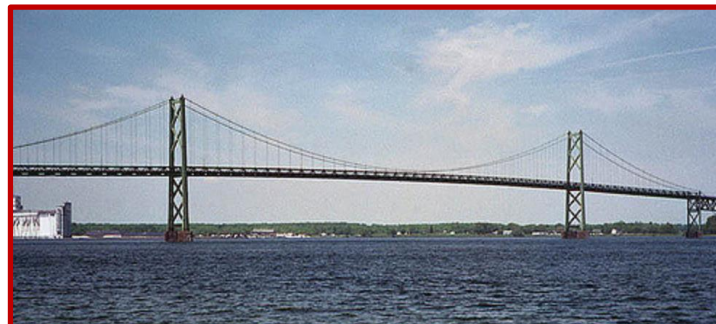
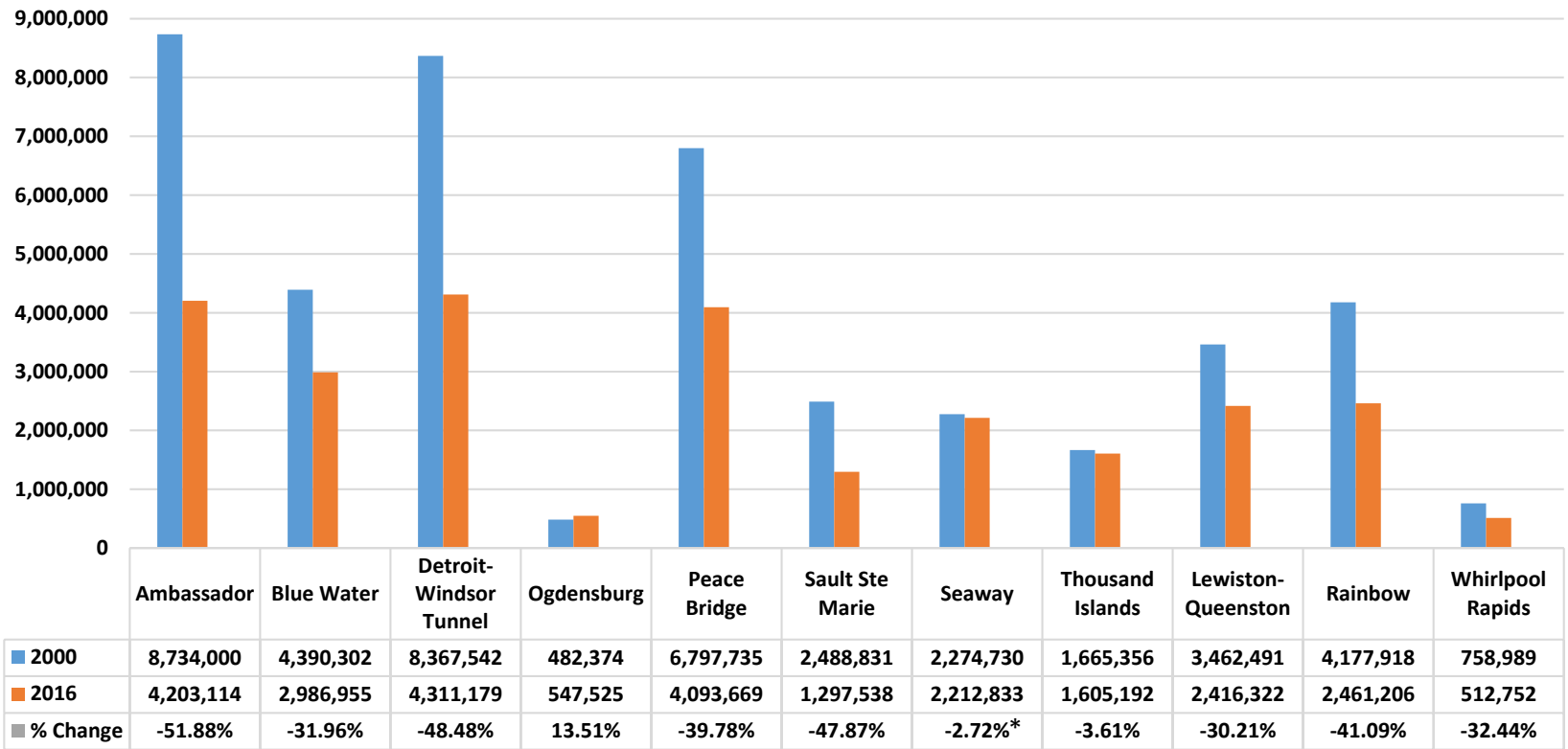

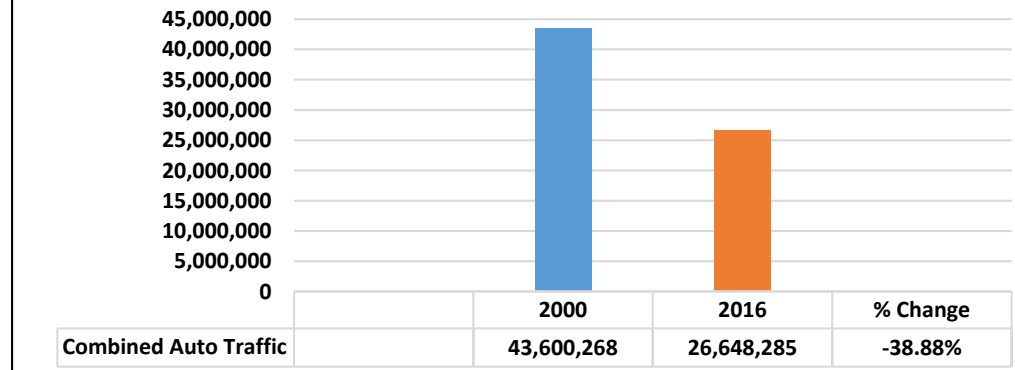


Autos Year 2000 vs 2016

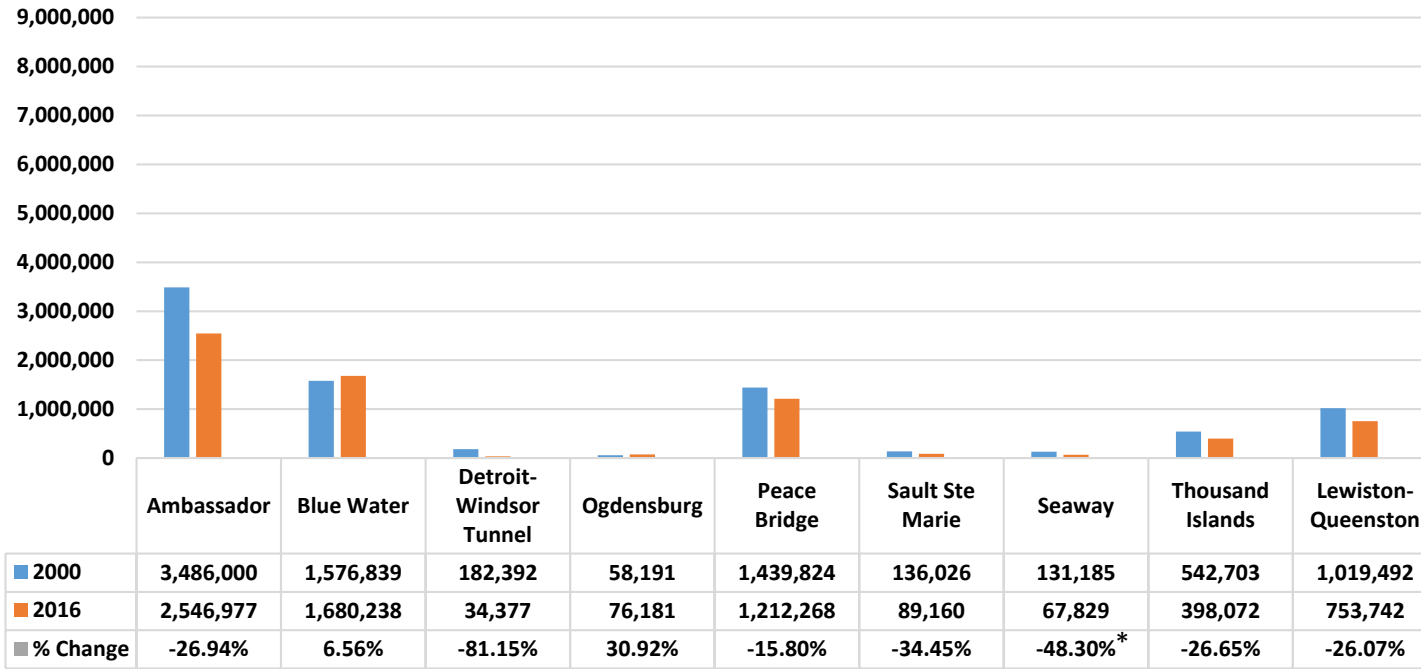

Total PBOA Border Crossings Autos Year 2000 vs 2016



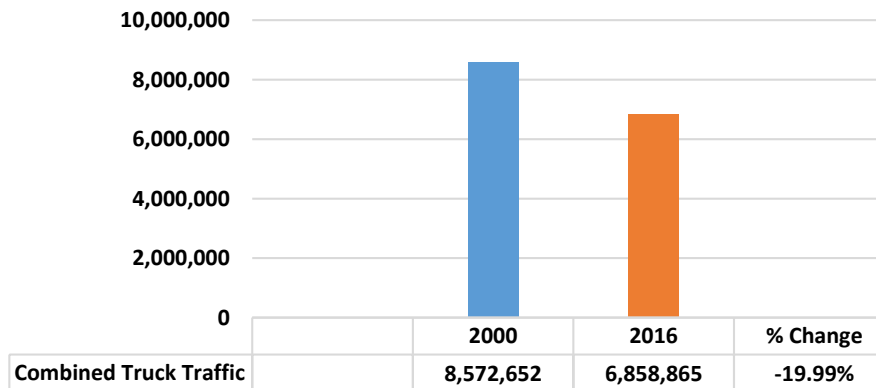
Trucks Year 2000 vs 2016

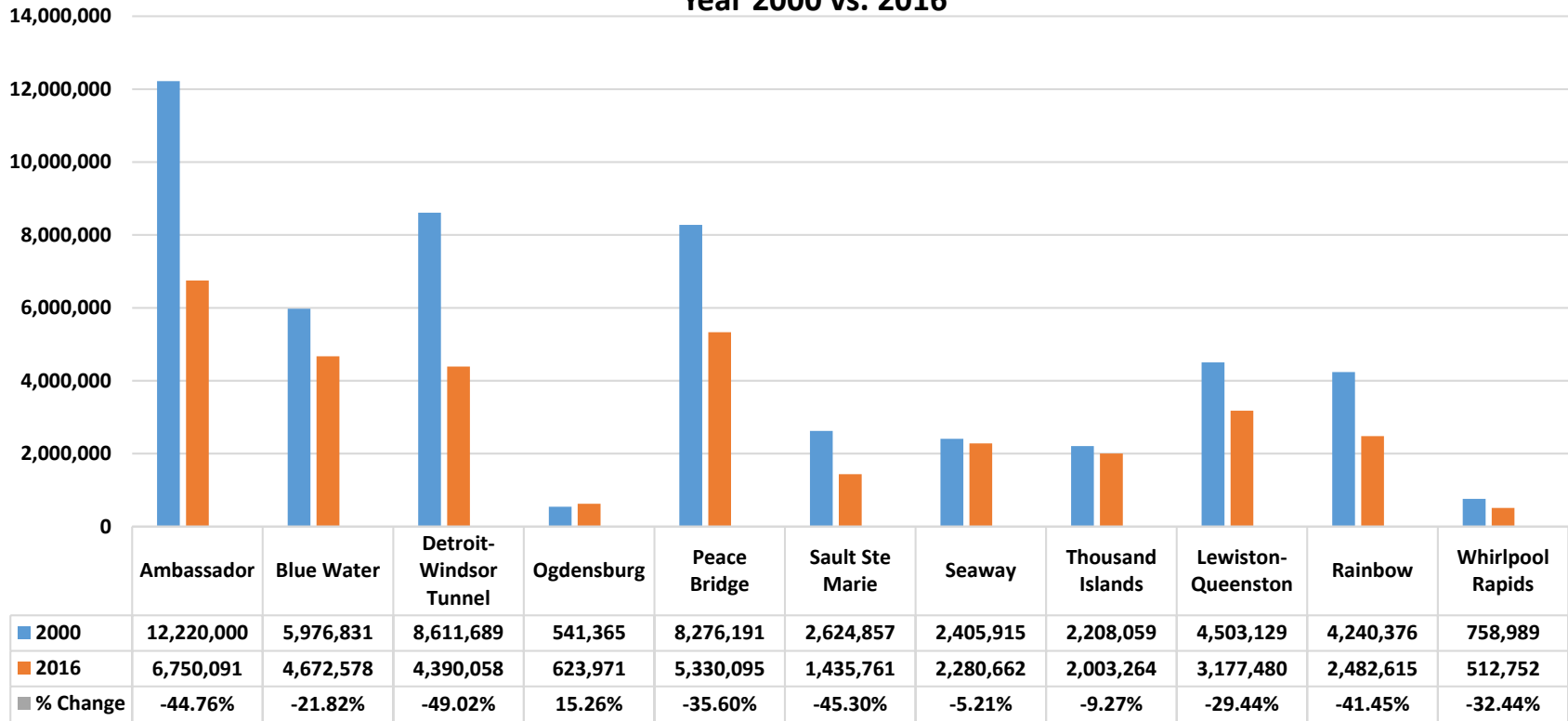
